



WHO ARE WE?

The Women's Fund is an initiative to bring women together for the purpose of "making a positive impact on the lives of women and children of South Central Kentucky, now and forever" by collectively funding significant grants to charitable organizations with the same purpose.

WHAT IS A FUND?

The Women's Fund is both a permanent endowment fund and a nonpermanent fund established to benefit women and children; it is housed within The Community Foundation of South Central Kentucky. The permanent fund is building a legacy that will impact the lives of women and children in our area forever! The nonpermanent fund provides a significant financial grant annually.

HOW ARE FUNDS GRANTED?

At the end of each grant cycle, an annual dinner of the membership is held, where four (4) grant finalists are invited to make a presentation about their funding request. Each member will cast their one vote in person or by proxy at the annual dinner. The recipient of the grant will be determined by majority vote of the fund members, and the grant recipient will be announced and awarded that day.

HOW CAN I BECOME MORE THAN A MEMBER?

Volunteer for one of the many committees. To find out more go to www.cfsky.org and click on the Women's Fund tab. All Committee members must be Women's Fund members and are asked to commit to serve a minimum of two years.

HOW TO BECOME A VOTING MEMBER

There are five levels of membership. Each vote is weighted in relation to level of membership.

○ LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP

One (1) individual contributes a total of \$25,000, payment options are available. The individual shall retain one (1) vote per year for their lifetime and the member may have one successor.

○ FULL MEMBERSHIP 110%

A woman who contributes \$1,100 or more with \$100 going to the administrative fund, paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one (1) vote per year.

○ FULL MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$1,000 or more, paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one (1) vote per year.

○ HALF MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$500 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one half (½) vote per year.

○ QUARTER MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$250 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one quarter (¼) vote per year.

○ JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

A woman 25 years and younger who contributes \$125 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one eighth (⅛) vote per year.

It is hard to express to you the emotion we felt last year when our name was announced as the recipient of the \$110,000 Impact Grant. We work so hard to fulfill our mission of building strength, stability and self-reliance through shelter, but sometimes that challenge can feel daunting. It wasn't just about receiving the grant, it was feeling the support from the community. Some of you have even joined us to swing a hammer or install some insulation as a part of this project. That support has flooded over into all of our work and we have built upon that momentum all year long.

The City of Bowling Green recently completed a Housing Needs Assessment of our community. Their study revealed some pretty important issues in our community. The poverty rate in KY is 18.5, but in the City of Bowling Green it is 27. One out of four children faces the battle with poverty. The Women's Fund of South Central Kentucky's Impact Grant is helping to win that battle for five families who will move into their new affordable townhomes this fall! There are 29 individuals in these five families that will have a hand up in the fight against poverty because of your generosity. We are working hard to be able to hand over the keys to their brighter future.

We are so grateful to have the Women's Fund of Southern KY as partners in our mission. Soon we will begin handing over the keys and saying "Welcome Home"—your impact made that possible. The children in these homes will experience security and stability giving them more confidence in their progress through school—your impact made that happen. These families and these kids will be given the opportunity to break out of the cycle of poverty and **YOUR IMPACT GRANT MADE THAT A POSSIBILITY!**
