WHO ARE WE?

The Women's Fund is an initiative to bring women together for the purpose of "making a positive impact on the lives of women and children of South Central Kentucky, now and forever" by collectively funding significant grants to charitable organizations with the same purpose.

WHAT IS A FUND?

The Women's Fund is both a permanent endowment fund and a nonpermanent fund established to benefit women and children; it is housed within The Community Foundation of South Central Kentucky. The permanent fund is building a legacy that will impact the lives of women and children in our area forever! The nonpermanent fund provides a significant financial grant annually.

HOW ARE FUNDS GRANTED?

At the end of each grant cycle, an annual dinner of the membership is held, where four (4) grant finalists are invited to make a presentation about their funding request. Each member will cast their one vote in person or by proxy at the annual dinner. The recipient of the grant will be determined by majority vote of the fund members, and the grant recipient will be announced and awarded that day.

HOW CAN I BECOME MORE THAN A MEMBER?

Volunteer for one of the many committees. To find out more go to www.cfsky.org and click on the Women's Fund tab. All Committee members must be Women's Fund members and are asked to commit to serve a minimum of two years.

HOW TO BECOME A VOTING MEMBER

There are five levels of membership. Each vote is weighted in relation to level of membership.

○ LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP

One (1) individual contributes a total of \$25,000, payment options are available. The individual shall retain one (1) vote per year for their lifetime and the member may have one successor.

○ FULL MEMBERSHIP 110%

A woman who contributes \$1,100 or more with \$100 going to the administrative fund, paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one (1) vote per year.

○ FULL MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$1,000 or more, paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one (1) vote per year.

○ HALF MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$500 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one half (½) vote per year.

○ QUARTER MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$250 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one quarter (¼) vote per year.

○ JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

A woman 25 years and younger who contributes \$125 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one eighth (⅛) vote per year.

Gifts of any amount are appreciated and all who donate will be invited to the Annual Dinner.

To say that 2020 has been a challenging year would be an understatement. The obstacles we are facing in our country and our local community have seemed daunting. It can be easy to focus on the things that are not going right—lives lost, high unemployment, special events missed, and being separated from our friends and family. Certainly, many members of our Women's Fund have been impacted in very real ways.

However, I must remind myself that in times of great struggle we can also find many things to be thankful for if we take the time to look. We can also use this opportunity to effect positive change in ways that are within our control, at a time when a lot of things are out of our control.

Our Women's Fund Advisory Board agreed we needed to take quick and thoughtful action to rapidly address urgent community needs created by the COVID-19 pandemic. We significantly modified our 2020 grant process. In April, we granted \$43,812 to the COVID-19 Crisis Fund. This was funded by 2020 earnings from the endowment fund. Next, we accelerated the timing of both our member voting and grant-making process to provide grants to nonprofits in August, rather than at our Annual Dinner in October. We granted a total of \$100,000 to 14 organizations, all of whom were top four finalists over the past seven years. This is a total community impact of \$143,812!

The Women's Fund has granted over \$866,000 since 2013. We now have over \$1,000,000 in our endowment fund. These are all reasons to celebrate! However, it's the story behind the numbers that's really the meaningful part—it's the BIG impact we are making on the individual lives of women, children and families in south central Kentucky. It's the first grader we have helped to educate about child abuse and prevention through Kids on the Block. It's the family who has found their affordable forever home through Habitat for Humanity. It's the single mother who now has a safe, warm place for her and her children to sleep at night through the Salvation Army. Your membership has made all of these projects (and more) possible.

As we look to what BIG impact we want to achieve in the coming year, please remember that every membership matters (and every vote counts). No one individual can solve the challenges impacting this community on their own, but when we work together, we can achieve amazing things. Please join me in saying,

2019 IMPACT GRANT RECIPIENT UPDATE: KIDS ON THE BLOCK



When we spoke at the 2019 award ceremony, we laid out our plans for the next three years. We never could have imagined how important it would be to South Central Kentucky children for us to launch our second troupe in 2020. 2020—The year COVID-19 happened. In-person education being replaced by home schooling, brought with it an absence of normal checks and balances provided by teachers and other trusted protectors engaging with children. Children became trapped in their home with sexual and physical abusers, and neglect went unseen.

Rather than shutting down, our staff, board, and advisors made the decision to forge ahead. We trained our two new Women's Fund hired puppeteers. We recorded child abuse programs in our office and uploaded them to social media for children to view from home. Katie and Caitlin were meant to join our team this year. We are ready to send them out with our new Child Abuse Prevention puppets. The original troupe also has new puppets. We continued holding fundraisers, careful to protect the children and adults participating. The Protect Child Abuse Kentucky conference even moved online, with workshops being held throughout September.

Ahead of schools reopening, we developed alternatives to make sure we could continue to reach children. Schools can opt to bring us into individual classrooms for in-person performances, and we will also offer virtual programs which still allow students to interact with our puppeteers.

We currently have 18 Women's Fund Child Abuse programs scheduled for this school year. We will have even more scheduled by the time this report reaches the Women's Fund members. Instead of offering 19 topics, we are offering three per grade level, focusing on the topics that present immediate needs for intervention and prevention. Child Abuse is one of the three programs being offered at every grade level. In conjunction we also developed a special Coronavirus program to offer to help children understand the current world where they are learning and growing.

WOMEN'S FUND OF SOUTH CENTRAL KENTUCKY GRANT RECIPIENTS 2020

To rapidly address urgent community needs created by the COVID-19 pandemic, the Women's Fund did a one-time modification to our 2020 grant process. We accelerated the timing of both the member voting and grant-making, to provide funds to nonprofits in March & September, rather than our normal timing in October. A total of \$143,812 was granted in 2020!

In March \$43,812.11 was given to the COVID-19 Crisis Fund, administered by United Way of Southern Kentucky. The donation, which is 100% of the Women's Fund's 2020 endowment earnings, was unanimously approved by the advisory board to rapidly address the urgent needs of the community. A total of 10 nonprofits were impacted by this grant.

Many local nonprofits have faced cancelled fundraisers, resulting in a loss of essential operating revenue. In consideration of these needs, the Advisory Board decided to make unrestricted grants and to invest in operating capacity rather than soliciting specific grant requests from each nonprofit. To continue giving our members a voice and a vote, the 14 nonprofits that were our top 4 finalists over the past seven years made up the ballot. The \$100,000 was split between all 14 organizations, as reflected by the percentage of votes received from the members.

This \$100,000 in grants was in addition to the \$43,812 granted to the COVID-19 Crisis Fund in March, bringing the total impact in 2020 to \$143,812.

\$6,000 was dedicated to supporting food banks and other vital food resources through providing financial resources to help prevent hunger and lack of nutrition resources.

- Edmonson County Schools: \$2,500 allocated to the Family Resource Center
- Logan County Schools: \$1,000 allocated to Meal Service
- Warren County: \$2,500 allocated to the Salvation Army

\$26,812 was designated for programs working to prevent growth in homelessness due to the economic impacts of COVID-19 by aiding low-income individuals and families through emergency support such as rental, utility, and emergency assistance.

- Simpson County: \$2,812 allocated to Community Action
- Warren County: \$9,000 allocated to Hope House, \$5,000 allocated to HOTEL INC, and \$10,000 to Salvation Army of Bowling Green.

\$11,000 was dedicated to organizations to fund the purchase of much-needed PPE, cleaning, and hygiene supplies.
