While 2020 was such a challenging year for so many, we had hoped that in 2021 we would see our community recover. However, due to the continuing impact of the Covid-19 crisis in our community and the impact on many of our local nonprofit organizations, the Women's Fund Advisory Board agreed to a modified 2021 grant process. The 2021 grant process will award six grants to nonprofits that benefit women, children, and families in South Central Kentucky. The six impact grants to be awarded this year are: \$60,000, \$30,000, \$20,000, \$15,000, \$10,000, \$10,000, for a total community impact of \$145,000.

With this 2021 grant of \$145,000, the Women's Fund will have granted over \$1,000,000 to organizations in South Central Kentucky.

Thank you for your membership and your commitment to the Women's Fund. Every member is important in achieving our impact for women, children and families. # HOW TO BECOME A VOTING MEMBER

There are five levels of membership. Each vote is weighted in relation to level of membership.

### **OLIFETIME MEMBERSHIP**

One (1) individual contributes a total of \$25,000, payment options are available. The individual shall retain one (1) vote per year for their lifetime and the member may have one successor.

### **FULL MEMBERSHIP 110%**

A woman who contributes \$1,100 or more with \$100 going to the administrative fund, paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one (1) vote per year.

#### OFULL MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$1,000 or more, paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one (1) vote per year.

### **OHALF MEMBERSHIP**

A woman who contributes \$500 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one half ( $\frac{1}{2}$ ) vote per year.

### **QUARTER MEMBERSHIP**

A woman who contributes \$250 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one quarter (1/4) vote per year.

### **OJUNIOR MEMBERSHIP**

A woman 25 years and younger who contributes \$125 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one eighth (1/2) vote per year.

### GIFTS

Gifts of any amount are appreciated and all who donate will be invited to the Annual Dinner.

## WHO ARF WF?

The Women's Fund is an initiative to bring women together for the purpose of "making a positive impact on the lives of women and children of South Central Kentucky, now and forever" by collectively funding significant grants to charitable organizations with the same purpose.

## WHAT IS A FUND?

The Women's Fund is both a permanent endowment fund and a nonpermanent fund established to benefit women and children; it is housed within The Community Foundation of South Central Kentucky. The permanent fund is building a legacy that will impact the lives of women and children in our area forever! The nonpermanent fund provides a significant financial grant annually.

## HOW ARE FUNDS GRANTED?

At the end of each grant cycle, an annual dinner of the membership is held, where four (4) grant finalists are invited to make a presentation about their funding request. Each member will cast their one vote in person or by proxy at the annual dinner. The recipient of the grant will be determined by majority vote of the fund members, and the grant recipient will be announced and awarded that day.
