A DECADE OF IMPACT

Ten years ago, a small group of visionary women came together to create the Women's Fund of South Central Kentucky. They saw the area's immediate needs – women, children and families seeking shelter, support, safe environments, education and more. They also envisioned a legacy that would continue to grow from the membership and endowment fund, further impacting future generations. They believed women could do so much more collectively than they could do individually.

Through the generosity of 214 founding members, the first Impact Grant was awarded in 2013 to Barren River Area Safe Space, a regional domestic violence shelter. With its \$51,000 grant, BRASS added a handicap-accessible bathroom, furniture and play equipment. Other recipients that year, each receiving \$3,000, were Boys & Girls Club of Bowling Green, Junior Achievement and Kids on the Block.

A milestone was reached in 2015 when the grants total reached \$100,000 and membership had grown to 364. The \$85,000 Impact Grant was awarded to Haven4Change, which provides affordable housing and supportive services to women recovering from substance abuse and their children. From a new roof to new flooring, the entire facility was refurbished. Three finalists each received \$5,000.

Another milestone was reached in 2020: The endowment fund grew to more than \$1 million! However, 2020 also will be remembered for

the challenges members, the community and world at large encountered with the onset of COVID-19. In April 2020, the Women's Fund granted the endowment fund earnings of \$43,812 to the COVID-19 Crisis Fund. At the annual meeting, held virtually in August rather than in-person in October, the Women's Fund granted a total of \$100,000 to 14 organizations, all of whom were top four finalists over the past seven years, for a total community impact of \$143,812.

As the pandemic continued in 2021, the Women's Fund again adapted the grants process to help more organizations. Six nonprofit organizations received grants totaling \$145,000. Only a few weeks after the annual dinner was held in-person, following COVID-19 guidelines, the local community faced another tremendous challenge: devastation caused by the Dec. 10-11 tornadoes. The Women's Fund immediately donated \$10,000 from the endowment earnings to local tornado relief efforts.

Since the Women's Fund was organized a decade ago, members have awarded \$1,167,452 in grants, and the endowment fund has grown to over \$1.4 million! At this year's annual dinner, the Women's Fund will award a \$100,000 Impact Grant and three grants of \$15,000 each.

Through your support, the Women's Fund is making a positive impact on the lives of women, children and families of South Central Kentucky, now and forever.





WHO ARE WE?

The Women's Fund is an initiative to bring women together for the purpose of "making a positive impact on the lives of women and children of South Central Kentucky, now and forever" by collectively funding significant grants to charitable organizations with the same purpose.

WHAT IS A FUND?

The Women's Fund is both a permanent endowment fund and a nonpermanent fund established to benefit women and children; it is housed within The Community Foundation of South Central Kentucky. The permanent fund is building a legacy that will impact the lives of women and children in our area forever! The nonpermanent fund provides a significant financial grant annually.

HOW ARE FUNDS GRANTED?

At the end of each grant cycle, an annual dinner of the membership is held, where four (4) grant finalists are invited to make a presentation about their funding request. Each member will cast their one vote in person or by proxy at the annual dinner. The recipient of the grant will be determined by majority vote of the fund members, and the grant recipient will be announced and awarded that day.

HOW CAN I BECOME MORE THAN A MEMBER?

Volunteer for one of the many committees. To find out more go to www.cfsky.org and click on the Women's Fund tab. All Committee members must be Women's Fund members and are asked to commit to serve a minimum of two years.

HOW TO BECOME A VOTING MEMBER

There are five levels of membership. Each vote is weighted in relation to level of membership.

○ LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP

One (1) individual contributes a total of \$25,000; payment options are available. The individual shall retain one (1) vote per year for their lifetime and the member may have one successor.

○ FULL MEMBERSHIP 110%

A woman who contributes \$1,100 or more with \$100 going to the administrative fund, paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one (1) vote per year.

○ FULL MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$1,000 or more, paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one (1) vote per year.

○ HALF MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$500 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one half (½) vote per year.

○ QUARTER MEMBERSHIP

A woman who contributes \$250 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one quarter (¼) vote per year.

○ JUNIOR MEMBERSHIP

A woman 25 years and younger who contributes \$125 paid in full during the fiscal year [July 1—June 30], receives one eighth (⅛) vote per year.
